

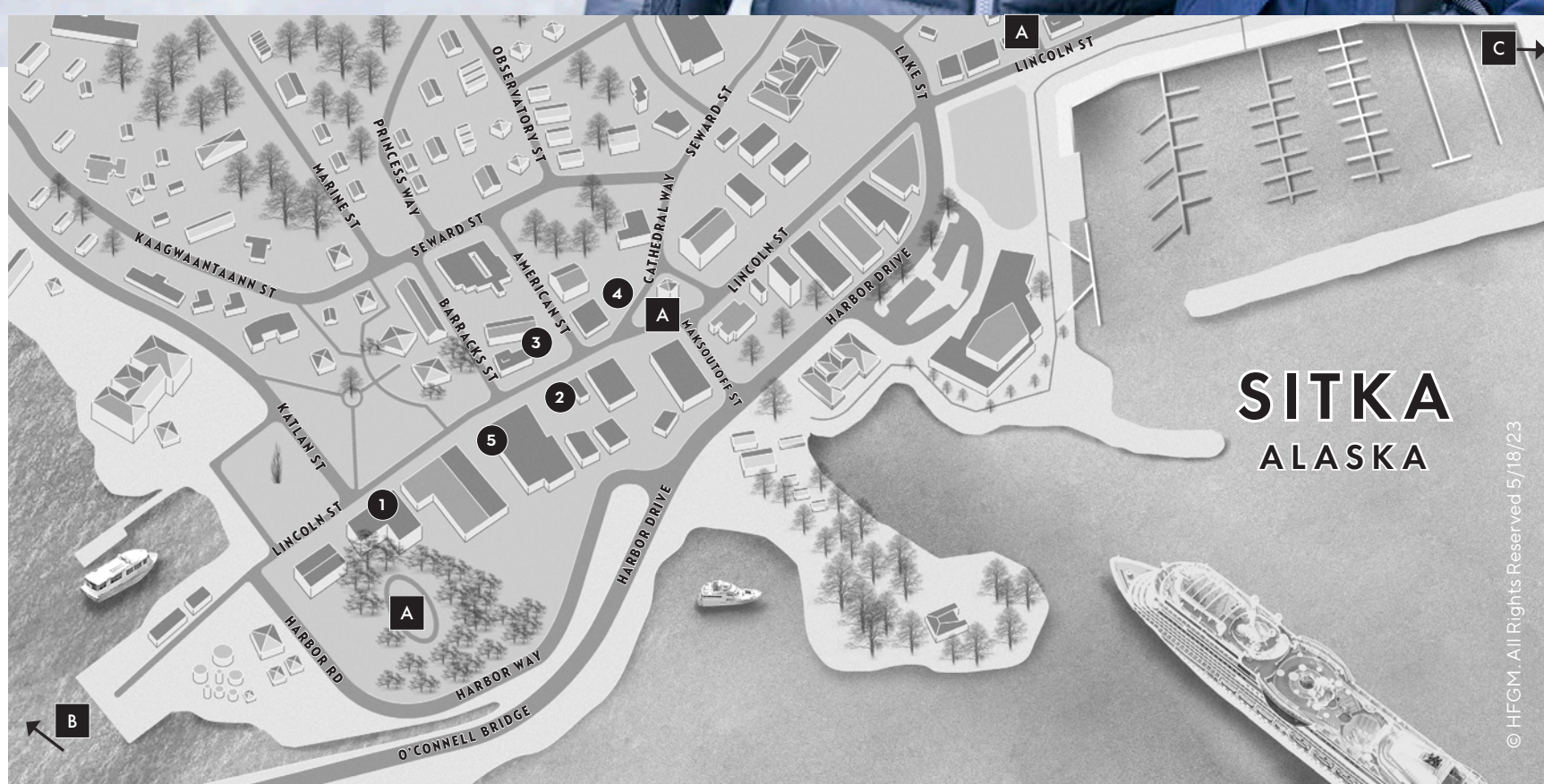
WELCOME TO SITKA

The small harbor town and commercial fishing hub is distinctive with Russian architecture and Tlingit traditions. Take it in at the onion dome of St. Michael's Orthodox Cathedral, or along the Totem Trail in Sitka National Historical Park. From your vacation destination on the Baranof Island (not accessible by vehicles) the Tongass National Forest calls to nature lovers, as does Sitka Sound and Mount Edgecumbe, the dormant volcano towering from the other side. Adventure seekers love the kayaking, fly-fishing, rafting, biking and hiking. Take it to the extremes with ATVs or cave exploration. Make sure to make time for some of the top shops on Lincoln Street while you're in town.

A RUSSIAN ARCHITECTURE OF SITKA

B CAVE EXPLORATION

Zip through the icy waters at speeds up to 50 MPH to an island coastline to explore caves created by a long-inactive volcano.



C SITKA NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

Trace the native heritage, see artifacts, watch a short film, walk the mile-long Totem Trail, then visit the Sitka Cultural Center.
